Happy Feet, serving children in need of new shoes, came about when we heard that local teachers and nurses were purchasing quality shoes for children who could not afford them. United Way of Rutland County does not believe our educators should have to do this, so we are truly grateful for the community support we receive for this wonderful program!



The Casella Relief Fund was established after front-line employees at the company were called to action providing critical cleanup through the State of Vermont. This led to the company establishing the Casella Relief Fund, providing \$100,000 of flood relief assistance for Vermonters.



Partnering with community donors, our **Welcome to Winter Program** provides outerwear to the children of Rutland County. Through collaboration of area schools, we are able to identify concerns and distribute according to need.



Building Strength Through Wellness Conference: In this interactive conference area social service professionals attended workshops
